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**ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.**

The claimant has filed this appeal aggrieved by the dismissal of his claim petition as he failed to lead any evidence relating to the damage caused to his vehicle.

The record of this case had been burnt in the fire incident which took place in 2011.

On the last date of hearing it had been stated that the lawyer who had filed the appeal had been elevated a number of years ago and they had sought time to take instructions. The case had been adjourned and four months' time was given to the appellant. Today the counsel states that they had contacted the counsel who was representing the appellant before the trial Court and he could not contact the litigant.

The claimant has been negligent and has not contacted any counsel for number of years. The claim petition had been dismissed by the Tribunal for want of evidence. No further steps are required to be taken.

The appeal is dismissed on merits.
