The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking bail in case FIR No.56 dated 26.04.2017 registered under Sections 363, 366-A, 376 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Sadar Raikot, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further contended that as per the FIR, the petitioner acted as facilitator in the alleged commission of crime. The material witnesses including complainant and the prosecutrix have been already examined. The petitioner is in custody since 04.05.2017.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes the bail application.

Heard.

Considering the fact that the challan stands already presented, the petitioner is in custody since 04.05.2017, the material witnesses have been already examined so, without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of trial, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/duty Magistrate concerned.
