The name of petitioner was disclosed by registered owner of the vehicle as driver of the truck from where fourteen cows were recovered in a very bad shape. Their legs were tied.

The statements of **Amar Singh and B. Singh** have also been recorded by the police to the effect that the petitioner was standing near the truck.

In my considered opinion, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is needed to crack the case in order to ascertain involvement of other accused in the case.

No indulgence can be granted in exercise of powers
under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
