The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 408, dated 28.06.2017, under Sections 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9 of the Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act 1956, registered at Police Station DLF, Phase-II, Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was working as a receptionist and has been falsely implicated in the case because of rivalry between the owner of the mall and the complainant. He further contends that the petitioner has been in custody since 28.06.2017 and similarly situated co-accused, namely, Halin has been granted regular bail by the trial Court on 30.06.2017. Learned counsel also contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially, when similarly situated co-accused, namely, Halin has been granted regular bail, I deem it a fit case to grant concession of regular bail to

the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Linah Chawang is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
