The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 44, dated 26.03.2017, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR was registered after five months of the incident and the petitioner has been in custody for over two and half months ever since the date of his arrest on 01.05.2017. He further contends that no other case is pending against the petitioner.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially in view of the fact that the petitioner has been in custody for over two and half months, I deem it appropriate to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Bachittar Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
