The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 47, dated 31.05.2017, under Sections 18/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR against the petitioner are that 60 grams of opium has been recovered from him. He further states that the petitioner is not involved in any other case and is in custody ever since the date of his arrest on 31.05.2017.

Learned State counsel does not controvert the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner.

Heard.

The recovery from the petitioner is 60 grams of opium, which is below the threshold of 2.5 kg. of commercial quantity. The petitioner has been in custody for over 02 months and is stated to be not involved in any other case. I deem it a fit case to grant concession of regular bail to the

petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Paramjit Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
