HARI PAL VERMA, J.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, namely, Punjab Singh in cross case registered vide DDR No.16 dated 24.03.2016 under Sections 307/326/324/323/148/149 IPC, Police Station Khem Karan, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-2) in FIR No.23 dated 23.03.2016 under Sections 326/323/427/379/506/148/149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Khem Karan, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the present case is a case of version and cross-version as the FIR (Annexure P-1) was registered against the complainant party on the statement of the brother of the petitioner, namely, Baj Singh.

Therefore, it is a counter-blast to the FIR registered against the

complainant's side with a sole motive to pressurize the petitioner and his family and to take possession of their land. No injury has been attributed to the petitioner. Nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner which may warrant his custodial interrogation.

Learned State has argued that the petitioner has caused injury with datar on the person of Jaimal Singh and the injured was inflicted as many as 15 injuries. As per the medical record of injured- Jaimal Singh, injuries No.4, 11 and 14 are dangerous in nature. The injured was admitted in the hospital on 01.03.2016 and was discharged on 23.03.2016.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the nature of injuries and the allegations against the petitioner, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
