This petition has been filed for seeking direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners; respondent Nos.4 to 10 not to harass or interfere in the married life of the petitioners; respondent Nos.2 and 3 not to entertain any criminal complaint against the petitioners.

The learned counsel for the petitioners states that assailants, namely, Salim, Nizar, Dildar and Gulzar assaulted the petitioners at the behest of private respondents.

The learned counsel for respondent Nos.4 to 10, on instructions, submit that respondent Nos.4 to 10 have no concern with the marriage of the petitioners and they have accepted the marriage. Neither respondent Nos.4 to 10 interfered in the marriage of the petitioners nor harassed the petitioners. Further, they undertake that they will not interfere in the matrimonial life of the petitioners.

The learned State counsel states that necessary action has already been initiated against the accused persons. However, no evidence could show that assailants caused injuries at the behest of respondent Nos.4 to 10.

Heard.

In view of above, no further action is warranted in the matter.
