Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his other family members.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that an agreement to sell dated 26.12.2015 was executed by respondent No.4-Jagdish Singh in favour of the petitioner-Bhupinder Singh and the due date for execution of the sale deed is 26.12.2017. On the date of execution of agreement dated 26.12.2015, the petitioner paid a sum of ₹1 lakh to the respondent No.4. Again on 04.03.2016, an amount of ₹1 lakh was paid to the respondent No.4. However, before the due date of execution of the sale deed, respondent No.4 has transferred the land in favour of his wife-respondent No.5. Now the respondents, instead of executing the sale deed, have started harassing the petitioner and also threatening

For the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 26.06.2017 (Annexure P-4), addressed to Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural i.e. respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Amritsar to look into the petitioner's representation dated 26.06.2017 (Annexure P-4).

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of copies of paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without making any observation about the claim as projected by the petitioner in the representation (Annexure P-4), the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Amritsar to look into the contents of the aforesaid representation dated 26.06.2017 (Annexure P-4) and take appropriate action thereon in accordance with law.
