Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to provide adequate security and to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members at the hands of respondents No.4 to 9.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the daughter of the petitioner, namely, Poonam got married with Sukhpreet Singh, who is the son of respondents No.4 and 5. However, after the marriage, Sukhpreet Singh has gone abroad. Now, respondents No.4 and 5 are unnecessarily harassing the petitioner.

For the aforesaid grievance, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 29.06.2017 (Annexure P-4), addressed to Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana i.e. respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana to look into the grievance of the petitioner as projected in the aforesaid representation dated 29.06.2017 (Annexure P-4).

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of copies of paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without making any observation about the claim as projected by the petitioner, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana to look into the contents of the aforesaid representation dated 29.06.2017 (Annexure P-4) and take appropriate action thereon in accordance with law.
