Petitioners-Gagandeep Singh alias Gagg @ Kulwinder Singh and Kulveer Singh alias Kinda have filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.199 dated 17.12.2016 (wrongly mentioned in the impugned order as to be dated 17.02.2016), registered at Police Station City Kotkapura, District Faridkot, under Sections 307, 341, 323 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and complainant has also appeared through his counsel. They contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner; learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the complainant and have gone through the record.

As per the prosecution version, petitioner No.1-Gagandeep Singh alias Gagg @ Kulwinder Singh is stated to be armed with iron rod and has caused three injuries on the knee of injured which fall under Section 325 IPC. Petitioner No.2-Kulveer Singh alias Kinda is also stated to be armed with iron rod and has caused simple injuries to the injured. Both the petitioners are not the main accused. The injury dangerous to life has been attributed to co-accused namely Gulab Singh.

The petitioners have been in custody since 01.05.2017. They are not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as they are in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioners in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
