The present petition has been filed under Section 438 the Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.165 dated 10.03.2012, registered under Sections 148, 302, 307, 395, 396, 397, 186, 332, 353, 120-B read with Section 149 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, at Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.

It is contended that except the disclosure statement made by co-accused Naresh @ Sethi, there is no evidence to connect the petitioner with the alleged crime. No recovery has been made from the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 04.04.2012.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes the bail application.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the case file.

Allegations against the petitioner are that he supplied cartridges after arranging the same from co-accused, Balraj @ Billu. Three persons namely, Siri Bhagwan, Dilbagh and Anil @ Fauji died and two were injured in the incident when they were being taken from Bhondsi Jail to District Court, Rohtak in the vehicle of the Jail Authorities. Sumit Rana @ Sunny, Parvesh, Satish, Raj Kumar, Mohit Sharma, Pawan allegedly fired in the incident whereas Arun Hooda, Deepak @ Baniya and Ranbir have been shown to be the conspirators.

Keeping in view the role prayed by the petitioner, no case for grant of bail is made out. Consequently, the petition is dismissed.
