LISA GILL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner, who is an accused in FIR No.0089, dated 3rd June, 2017 under Sections 376, 506 IPC registered at Women Police Station, District Faridabad, seeks directions for transfer of investigation to some other independent Agency. It is averred that a false case has been registered against the petitioner. He has brought to the notice of the authorities that the complainant had earlier filed similar complaints against other persons and had thereafter, compromised the matter.

Furthermore, complainant had also filed a complaint against the petitioner at Police Station Sarai Khwaja stating that some money was borrowed by the petitioner from her and he was not returning the same. The said amount was returned to her in the presence of the police officials. Thereafter, the complainant started threatening the petitioner and his father that in case, the petitioner did not marry her, she would implicate the petitioner and his family in some false case. Representation dated 3rd May, 2017 (Annexure P-2) in this regard was submitted by the petitioner's

father. Thereafter, a complaint was filed by the complainant at Women Cell, Faridabad, pursuant to which legal notice dated 23rd May, 2017 (Annexure P-3) was sent by the petitioner's father to the complainant. The FIR in question, it is submitted, has been registered thereafter in an arbitrary manner.

It is argued that all these facts are brought to the notice of the Investigating Agency but the same are not being looked into.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

It is not in dispute that the petitioner is an accused in this case and matter is still under investigation. This Court is sanguine that the Investigating Agency shall look into all the aspects of the matter while proceeding with the investigation. It is to be noted that no *mala fide* have been alleged against the investigating agency. Therefore, at this stage when the matter is pending investigation no orders from this Court are called for in this case.

Petition is accordingly, disposed of.
