Petitioner-Sandeep @ Pehal has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.94 dated 05.03.2016, registered at Police Station Matlauda, Panipat, under Sections 307, 392 and 397 of IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the allegations, the petitioner alongwith co-accused snatched ₹8,100/-, driving licence, mobile phone etc. on gun point from the complainant. There are seven

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more FIRs registered against the petitioner under the serious offences like Sections 307, 379-A, 395, 396 etc. The complainant has already been examined in this case, who has identified the present petitioner.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of nature and gravity of the offence, however, without without discussing the facts in minute detail, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
