ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.39 dated 21.09.2016, under Sections 326, 506 & 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Qadian, Police District Batala (Annexure P-1), on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the afore-noted FIR is the offshoot of a matrimonial dispute, which has now been resolved. The petitioners and the complainant are residents of the same village and want to lead peaceful life.

This Court by the order dated 29.08.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to record the statements of the parties with regard to genuineness of the compromise and send a report to this Court. The report of JMIC, Batala, dated 22.09.2017 has been received, wherein it is stated

that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded which indicates that the compromise is genuine, without any coercion or undue influence.

The FIR is an offshoot of a matrimonial dispute, which has now been resolved. The injuries are on the non-vital parts of the body of the complainant. The petitioners and the complainant are residents of the same village and want to lead peaceful life.

In view of the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466***, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.39 dated 21.09.2016, under Sections 326, 506 & 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Qadian, Police District Batala (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioner(s).
