On the asking of the Court, Mr. V.G. Jauhar, Senior Deputy
Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice.

In this petition, the petitioner, who is a contractor by profession seeks directions upon the respondents to protect his life and liberty along with that of his employees/workers, who are engaged for loading and unloading of food grains by the Food Corporation of India, but likely to face danger from the private respondent Nos.5 to 11, who are all active members of the Labour Union of the Food Corporation of India FSD, Ferozepur, and are allegedly bent upon disrupting the smooth functioning of the petitioner's activities.

In the circumstances, without adverting to the merits of the allegations disclosed in the petition, the same is disposed of with a direction upon respondent Nos.1 to 4 to take cognizance of the petitioner's grievances and, thereafter, to act appropriately in accordance with law.
