The petitioners by way of present criminal petition filed under Section 482 Cr. P.C. seek protection of their life and liberty as they are facing threats from respondents No. 4 and 5.

It is stated that respondent No. 4-Saroop Singh, is a retired Police Inspector and remained posted as SHO in the Police Station of the area where the petitioners are now residing.

I have heard learned counsel for both the parties and have carefully gone through the case file. It is found that it is for the Police to assess the threat perception with regard to the petitioners and take corrective measures.

In the circumstances, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Director General of Police, Punjab to assess the threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioners and in case it is found that there is any threat to life and liberty of the petitioners, necessary corrective measures be taken thereof.
