There is some ambiguity in the pleadings of para No.6 of the petition. Petitioners submitted that their marriage was solemnized on 18.01.2017, but due to typographical error, the date of marriage has been shown as 23.01.2017. The error is claimed to be typographical error in view of marriage certificate (Annexure P3). The marriage certificate and the photographs evidencing marriage have been placed on the file. It is alleged that they apprehend danger from respondents No.4 and 5. To seek redressal of their grievance, they have submitted representation dated 18.01.2017 (Annexure P5) to the Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar.

Without commenting on the age of the petitioners and validity of their marriage, directions are given to the Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar to decide the representation of the petitioners (Annexure P5) within one month from today, keeping in view the threat perception of the

petitioners.

However, it is made clear that if any criminal case is pending against the petitioners then this order shall not debar the respondents from proceeding in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of.
