Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners Kura Singh and Lachhman Singh @ Kala in case registered by way of FIR No.69 dated 16.06.2016 at Police Station Passiana, District Patiala under Sections 353/186/332/452/427/148/149 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 20.07.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Manjeet Singh from Police Station Passiana, District Patiala who submits that the petitioners are no longer required for further investigation and nothing is

to be recovered from them and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 20.07.2017 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). The petitioners shall also abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and thereafter, they will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
