INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Bhola Singh has filed this 2nd petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.121 dated 22.10.2016, registered at Police Station City Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, under Sections 308, 341, 323, 506, 427, 148 and 149 of IPC (Section 307 of IPC has been added and Section 308 of IPC has been deleted in the challan).

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, present petitioner, Bhola Singh, opened the door of car and dragged out

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the brother of the complainant from the car and raised *lalkara*. He has been stated to be armed with *daang* and caused injury on the nose of brother of the complainant.

The petitioner has been in custody since 16.11.2016. He is not the main accused. He is now not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
