FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

The allegations against the petitioner in this regular bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C are that the present case was got registered on the basis of secret information received by the Police, wherein it was alleged that the petitioner was having association with Babbar Khalasa International Organisation claimed to be a terrorists organisation and has an association with one Hardeep Singh Nijjar and was funding for unlawful activities and they were in regular contact with each other and were also instrumental in spreading terrorism in the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is no semblance of evidence for the offences in which the petitioner has been hauled up. With all fairness learned State counsel acceded at bar that there is not even an iota of evidence to link the petitioner with any of such activities and has clearly acceded to the fact that the petitioner is in custody

since 24.5.2016.

Keeping in view the stand of the State and the fact that there is no semblance of evidence to attract the commission of offences under Sections 124-A, 153-A and 120-B IPC and under Sections 10, 16, 18 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 as well as under Section 25 of the Arms Act and that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars, without adverting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition for grant of regular bail is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
