Petitioner-Narsingh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.526 dated 22.10.2016, registered at Police Station Manesar, District Gurgaon, under Sections 120-B, 420, 467 and 468 IPC and Section 328 IPC added later on.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared on behalf of respondent-State and complainant also appeared through her counsel. They contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that as per the allegations, the present petitioner purchased the property which has been sold by co-accused on the basis of forged power of attorney.

The petitioner has been in custody since 15.11.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
