Petitioner has preferred this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner which is in danger at the hands of respondents No.4 to 16.

Learned counsel for the petitioner only prays for the relief that the representation dated 15.06.2017 (Annexure P-1), moved to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, by the petitioner-Harish Kumar, be considered and he does not press the other relief asked in this petition.

In view of above, respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar is directed to look into the said representation (Annexure P-1) and pass appropriate order within two months, as per law, after receiving the certified copy of this order. However, it is made clear that this order in no way be construed for registration of the FIR.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed of.
