Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to take legal action on the complaint submitted by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that on the complaint addressed to the Deputy Commissioner, Kapurthala, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala was directed to look into the contents of the complaint and take necessary action on the same as per law. But despite the aforesaid remarks of the Deputy Commissioner, the grievance of the petitioner has not been looked into. Therefore, the petitioner submitted another complaints dated 22.03.2017 (Annexure P-6) addressed to Deputy Commissioner, Kapurthala and complaint dated 24.06.2017 (Annexure P-7) addressed to SHO, P.S. Sadar, Kapurthala, but no action thereof has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Simranjeet Kaur, AAG, Punjab, notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of copies of paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without making any observation on the claim as projected by the petitioner, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala to look into the contents of the aforesaid complaint dated 24.06.2017 (Annexure P-7) and take appropriate action thereon in accordance with law.
