Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to official respondents to investigate the matter and in alternative to transfer the investigation to some other agency.

Learned State counsel has filed the status report by way of an affidavit dated 8.9.2017 of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Dirba, District Sangrur, today in Court. The same is taken on record. As per the said affidavit, it is submitted that matter was investigated by S.P. Investigation, Sangrur and as per the report dated 19.12.2016, allegations in the FIR were not found to be substantiated. It is further submitted that SSP, Sangrur vide order dated 20.12.2016 has approved the cancellation report prepared in this case; the same has already been submitted before the trial Court on 18.8.2017 and trial Court has issued notice to the complainant for 24.10.2017.

In view of the same, present petition has become infructuous.

Disposed of as infructuous.

However, it will be open for the petitioner to file a protest petition in case of any grievance, in accordance with law.
