The petitioners are seeking a direction to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty as they apprehend danger from respondents No. 4 and 5.

It is stated in the petition that the date of birth of petitioner No. 1 is 05.05.1999 and petitioner No. 2 is 07.08.1984. Copies of Matriculation Certificate and Adhaar Card of petitioner No. 1 and copy of Driving License of petitioner No. 2 are annexed with the petition as Annexures P-1, P-2 and P-3. They are stated to have solemnized their marriage on 12.06.2017. The copy of marriage certificate and photographs in this regard are annexed as Annexures P-4 and P-5 respectively. It is further stated in the petition that the petitioners had also made a representation dated 07.07.2017 (Annexure P-6) to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar but no action has so far been taken thereon.

Issue notice to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

At the asking of the Court Mr. H.S. Grewal, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3.

Without expressing any opinion on the validity of the marriage and keeping in view the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *Lata Singh Vs. State of U.P. and another*, JT 2006(6) SC 173, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2- Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to look into the matter and take appropriate action in accordance with law to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of the private respondents.
