The petitioner is seeking quashing of order dated 05.09.2014 (Annexure P-7), whereby he has been declared as proclaimed person.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although the petitioner has been residing at House No.241, Street No.4, Upkar Nagar Civil Lines, Ludhiana for over a decade but warrants were pasted outside a place in Sahnewal.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner is facing trial under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, which is bailable. He has not been served at the address where he is stated to be residing at that time.

Consequently, the impugned order dated 05.09.2014 (Annexure P-7) is set aside. The petitioner shall appear before the trial Court within a week and submit his bail bonds to its satisfaction.
