The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.100 dated 24.06.2017 registered under Section 61/1/14 of Excise Act at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned State counsel submits that there is one more case against the petitioner in respect of 40 bottles of country made liquor. The present case relates to 36 bottles of country made liquor.

Be that as it may, the petitioner appears to be dealing in the illicit liquor, nevertheless, the petitioner undertakes to file undertaking that he would not indulge in similar offence hereinafter. In that view of the matter, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, however subject to some costs to the State. Hence, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) Rule is made absolute.
- (ii) CRL. MISC. No.M-25037 OF 2017 is allowed.

- (iii) The petitioner is granted anticipatory bail in the present FIR on furnishing fresh bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court, subject to deposit of ₹30,000/- with the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, within one week from today as a pre-condition. Failing which the police can arrest the petitioner, in the event of arrest.
- (iv) The petitioner shall give undertaking as aforesaid to the police that he will not indulge in such type of offence in future.
- (v) The petitioner shall continue to appear before the trial Court with promptitude till the completion of trial.
- (vi) Any further failure on the part of the petitioner shall result into taking him in custody by the trial Court.

Disposed of accordingly.
