This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 to 6 to take remedial action on the complaint dated 22.05.2017 (Annexure P-2) which has been submitted by the petitioner and prima facie make out a case under Sections 498-A, 406, 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur to consider and decide the complaint/representation dated 22.05.2017 (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. N.K.Banka, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

In the circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the

merits of the case, respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur is directed to ensure that appropriate authority i.e. respondent No.6-SHO Police Station NRI Cell, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur takes final decision in the matter and decide the complaint/representation dated 22.05.2017 (Annexure P-2), by passing a speaking order within a period of three weeks from the receipt of certified copy of the order.
