**REKHA MITTAL, J.(Oral)**

There is no possibility of any settlement at this stage. Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has already joined investigation in compliance with interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 01.08.2016, got recovered all the articles of jewellery claimed by the complainant and some of the household articles mentioned in the list (Annexure P-3/T) and he is not in possession of any other article.

Counsel for the State would submit that money given in cash and some domestic articles are yet to be recovered.

Counsel for the complainant has submitted that LCD and Air Conditioner recovered and handed over to the complainant are in broken condition.

In view of the above, the petition stands disposed of; interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 01.08.2016 is made absolute subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
- (ii) he shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) he shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.
