Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that vide order dated 28.03.2017 passed by this Court in CRM-M-31670-2016, titled as 'Birbal Singh Versus State of Punjab' seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.28 dated 23.02.2016 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur, the petitioner was admitted on anticipatory bail. He states that after the grant of anticipatory bail vide order dated 28.03.2017, the petitioner is being called by respondents No.4 and 5, who are Inspector and ASI, Economic Wing, Sangrur, respectively, despite the fact that they have no authority to call him.

Highlighting the aforesaid fact, petitioner has submitted a representation dated 04.07.2017 (Annexure P-2) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, District Sangrur i.e. respondent No.3, but no action thereon has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of copies of paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, District Sangrur, to look into the contents of aforesaid representation dated 04.07.2017 (Annexure P-2) and to act in accordance with law.
