Heard learned Counsel for the rival parties. Perused the impugned order as well as the FIR. Following are the averments in the FIR:-

“... On 14.12.2016 at about 2:30 PM I had started my motorcycle bearing No.PB 32 V9359 made of Bajaj CT-100 Black and blue colour and was just about to move to the house of my boss for taking lunch then one unidentified person shown knife and said leave aside otherwise he will kill me and therefore due to fear I went aside and thereupon the said unidentified person snatched my motorcycle and while snatching the motorcycle one paper fell down from his pocket which was later on I found insurance paper of the motorcycle of one Aslam s/o Mohammad Ali r/o Gurmail Nagar, Lohara H.No.5, Street No.2, Ludhiana. I am sure that my aforesaid motorcycle has been snatched by the said Aslam s/o Mohd. Ali r/o Gurmail Nagar, Lohara H.No.5, Street No.2, Ludhiana.”

Prima facie case is made out by the prosecution against the petitioner. Petitioner cannot be granted anticipatory bail. He may apply for

regular bail which shall be decided by the trial court within seven days of its filing.
