Petitioner-Arun Kumar Pubby has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.73 dated 15.04.2017, registered at Police Station Navi Biradari, Jalandhar, under Sections 409, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner is not the

main accused. He is stated to have gone to collect money on behalf of the main accused. As per the allegation, main accused-Gaurav Sehgal has embezzled the amount of Rs.50,000/-.

The petitioner has been in custody since 23.05.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case. Otherwise also, main accused-Gaurav Sehgal has already been released on bail by this Court vide order dated 19.07.2017 passed in CRM-M-24867-2017.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail; without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and on the ground of parity also, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
