Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No. 3 to 5 to comply with the provision of Section 160 Cr. P.C.

In the reply dated 26.9.2016, filed by Gurwinder Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sri Hargobindpur, Police District Batala, on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 5, it is submitted that in fact complaint dated 26.10.2015 was received in the office of Senior Superintendent of Police filed by Subedar- Sulakhan Singh against Gurdeep Singh-petitioner and the same was entrusted to concerned police official for inquiry and report. It is also submitted that respondent No. 7-Paramjit Singh and respondent No. 8-Kuldeep Singh have also submitted a complaint against the present petitioner with the allegation that he has taken an amount of ₹ 6.00 lacs on 25.3.2015 from the complainant to get employment for his two sons as Guards in Forest Department and has not returned money back. Accordingly, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Batala had summoned the parties by issuing notice under Section 160 Cr. P.C. for recording of their statements, however, they failed to appear.

It is specifically submitted in the affidavit that in both the complaints, petitioner and his son were summoned by issuing notice under Section 160 Cr. P.C by following proper procedure of law.

Accordingly, no further action is required in the present petition.
