HARI PAL VERMA J.

Petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. to direct the respondents No.1 to 4 to consider and decide the representation dated 16.1.2017 (Annexure P-4) and to initiate legal action against respondent No.5 by registering a case.

As per the averments made in the petition, the petitioner is resident of Village Sigri and belongs to Scheduled Caste. He is a BPL card holder. Under the Government Scheme, ration is to be supplied to BPL card holders at subsidised rates. The petitioner had submitted his ration card to the depot holder for taking goods but with dishonest intention, the depot holder kept the ration cards of the BPL card holders in his custody. The depot holder used to sell the goods in the market by depriving the

rights of the BPL card holders. The petitioner made a complaint against respondent No.5 to the Food and Supply Department. The matter has been reported to the State Vigilance Bureau, Gurugram Division, Gurugram, wherein an inquiry has been marked to Inspector Omparkash, who enquired into the matter and found that respondent No.5 has not distributed ration to the petitioner and other BPL card holders. Copy of the report dated 3.2.2017 has been placed on record as Annexure P-1.

The grievance of the petitioner has already been taken care by the respondents as Inspector Omparkash, State Vigilance Bureau has already investigated the matter and submitted the report dated 3.2.2017. Thereafter, there has been correspondence between the State Vigilance Bureau and the Director General, State Vigilance Bureau, Haryana, Panchkula. Therefore, once the matter has already been taken care by the respondent-State Vigilance Bureau, the prayer made by the petitioner in the present petition cannot be accepted.

Dismissed.
