Both these petitions have been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioners, namely, Jatin Kumar and Vishwajit Singh @ Vicky, in case FIR No.97 dated 22.05.2017, under Sections 379-B and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Navi Baradari, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that both the petitioners are in judicial lock up since 24.05.2017; the investigation has already been completed; challan has been presented and now, the case is fixed for framing of charges before the trial Court. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submit that in another FIR bearing No. 64, dated 20.05.2017, both the petitioners have already been acquitted, vide judgment dated 19.09.2017 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Jalnadhar and

the said FIR was registered just after two days of the registration of the instant FIR.

Learned State counsel submits that challan has been presented however, opposes the concession of bail to the petitioners.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, both the petitions are allowed. Petitioners namely, Jatin Kumar and Vishwajit Singh @ Vicky are directed to be released on regular bail subject to their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate concerned.

However, it will be open for the prosecution to apply for cancellation of bail in case the petitioner is found involved in any other subsequent case or found misusing concession of bail.
