TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.184, dated 16.11.2016, under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Canal Colony, District Bathinda.

As per prosecution version, an alleged recovery of 260 grams of contraband was effected from the petitioner. Even though petitioner was granted concession of interim bail awaiting the report of the chemical examiner but the same has since been received and the finding is that the salt of diacetylmorphine was present. The same would be construed as commercial quantity.

Under such circumstances, this Court is not inclined to extend in favour of the petitioner, concession of pre-arrest bail.

Petition dismissed.
