The instant writ petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction for the representation dated 27.05.2017 (Annexure P-3) to be decided expeditiously.

It is contended that despite the representation (Annexure P-3) has been moved, the official respondents are not taking any action on the same. Learned counsel for the petitioner urges that the representation should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Ms. Bhavna Gupta, DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that the official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the representation of the petitioners within a period of six weeks

months, on receipt of certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to her during the course of the day.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the representation dated 27.05.2017 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioners within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
