Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the official respondents for fair investigation in the case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for his grievance, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 13.02.2017 (Annexure P-4) to the Police Commissioner, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana i.e. respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Police Commissioner, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana to look into the grievance of the petitioner as projected in the representation dated 13.02.2017 (Annexure P-4).

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of copies of paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Police Commissioner, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana to look into the contents of aforesaid representation dated 13.02.2017 (Annexure P-4) and to act in accordance with law.
