The petitioners claim that on account of some demand of money, private respondents No. 6 to 9 are harassing them through the police. They are being repeatedly called to the police station. The proper remedy should have been to file a civil suit for recovery.

Notice of motion to State.

On asking of the Court, Mr. C.L. Pawar, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

In these circumstances, present petition is disposed of with directions to official respondents No. 1 to 5 not to summon the petitioners to the police station without issuing notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C., stating reasons for which their presence is required. Further, petitioners being women will not be called to any police station under Section 160 Cr.P.C., except Woman Police Station.
