The instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of appropriate directions to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners has been filed by the petitioners.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that he is withdrawing the petition as against respondents No.5 to 7 who are defendants in the civil suit. Ordered accordingly.

It is submitted that a civil suit by daughter of Beant Singh (petitioner No.1) had been filed against the petitioners and respondents No.5 to 7 which is pending at Civil Court, Ajnala. However, the petitioners are being repeatedly called by Balwinder Singh, ASI (respondent No.4) without even issuing a notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C., just to harass and pressurize them.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

Mr. Kuldeep Singh, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, takes notice of the petition on behalf of the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he will be satisfied if Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) is directed to look into the representation given by them as against respondent No.4.

Considering the submissions made, Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) to look into the representation (Annexure-P2) given by the petitioners as against respondent No.4.
