The instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and respondent No.8, which is stated to be in danger at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that after dissolution of marriage of petitioner No.1 with respondent No.4 by way of a decree of divorce (Annexure P-6), which has not been challenged till date, petitioner No.1 has been remarried with respondent No.8, and her minor son i.e. petitioner No.2 is living with them. The petitioners fear danger at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7, who are interfering in her matrimonial life.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Kuldeep Singh, Sr.DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he will be satisfied if respondent No.2- The Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar is directed to look into the representation Annexure P-8 given by petitioner No.1.

Without going into merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- The Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to look into the representation (Annexure P-8).
