SHEKHER DHAWAN, J.

Present petition under Section 439 cr.P.C. is for regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 136 dated 21.12.2016, under Sections 379B/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and he is in custody since 31.3.2017. Even PW-3 Rajesh Chauhan has admitted in his cross examination that he had seen the laptop for the first time in the Court and the police had not contacted him after December 2016. The trial of the case still to take some more time, so he may be released on bail.

Learned State counsel submitted that the trial is going on and no case is made out for release of the petitioner on bail. However, he affirmed the fact that there is no other case against the petitioner.

Having considered the facts that the petitioner is in custody since 31.3.2017 and decision of the case still to take some more time; without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the Court is of the view that no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner in custody, therefore, he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Yamuna Nagar.

The petition stands allowed.
