Petitioner-Tarsem Chand has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.63 dated 11.06.2017, registered at Police Station Sadar Mansa, District mansa, under Sections 22, 25 and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the recovery of tablets effected from the main accused falls in commercial quantity. The allegation against the present petitioner is that the main accused has taken the tablets from him. Vide order dated 10.07.2017, learned Additional Sessions Judge, Mansa while dismissing the anticipatory bail of the petitioner has held that

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the police file also contains the call details of the present petitioner with co-accused Vijay Kumar and Jagdev which shows that he has constant link on phone with co-accused.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
