The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 140, dated 04.04.2017, under Sections 170, 171, 419, 420, 468, 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector-5, Panchkula.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that while impersonating as Commissioner of Police, he had taken four mobile phones from the shop of the complainant and refused to make the payment thereof. Learned counsel further contends that the petitioner has been in custody for over four months ever since the date of his arrest on 04.04.2017.

The petitioner is stated to have taken four mobile phones from the shop of the complainant while impersonating as Commissioner of Police and has been in custody for over four months.

In view of the aforementioned facts and circumstances and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Vivek Saklani is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
