ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 47, dated 30.05.2017, under Sections 15/25/60/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Bhikhi, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and has been arraigned as an accused because he is owner of the vehicle. Three co-accused had been arrested from the spot along with 75 kgs. of poppy husk. He also contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other case and is in custody for over 06 months since his arrest on 01.06.2017.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Gurtej Singh, states that the challan has been filed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the
petitioner especially when the conclusion of the trial is likely to take

some time, I deem it a fit case to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Paramjit Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
