ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.63 dated 14.04.2017 under Section 22 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that 800 strips of 10 tablets each of Radadol SR 100 i.e 8000 tablets were recovered from his possession and he could not produce any license. When the matter had come up for hearing on 21.07.2017, learned State counsel had stated that the recovered substance had been found to be Tramadol Hydrochloride which is not mentioned in the NDPS Act but a definite opinion is being obtained.

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Learned State counsel, upon instructions from HC Tarsem Singh, states that definite opinion had been obtained which indicates that the substance is not covered under the NDPS Act.

In view of the above, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of bail. Therefore, without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner Navdeep Singh is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
