Petitioners have filed the present petition for issuance of direction to the respondents No.1 to 3 to protect their lives and liberty from the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned APP for U.T. Chandigarh has stated that the police has recorded the statement of respondent No.4, father of petitioner No.2, wherein he has stated that he has no objection to the marriage solemnized by the petitioners. Copy of the statement produced by learned APP for U.T. Chandigarh in Court today is taken on record. On the strength of the statement, so recorded, learned State counsel submits that petitioners do not have any threat to their life and liberty.

In view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is accordingly disposed of.

However, in case the petitioners still feel any danger to their lives, they are at liberty to approach respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T. Chandigarh.
