ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.200 dated 30.05.2017, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506 and 34 of the IPC (Sections 307 of the IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Basti Jodhewal, District Ludhiana, on the basis of compromise dated 04.07.2017(Annexure P-2), which has been arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is the outcome of a matrimonial dispute, which has been resolved with the intervention of the respectables. He also contends that although Section 307 of the IPC was added later on but the injury is on the left side of the stomach. Learned counsel further contends that the incident is of 30.05.2017 and the matter has been compromised after a month on 04.07.2017.

This Court by the order dated 19.07.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to record the statements of the parties with regard to genuineness of the compromise and send a report to this Court. The report of JMIC, Ludhiana, dated 14.08.2017 has been received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded which indicates that the compromise is genuine, without any coercion or undue influence.

The FIR is outcome of a matrimonial dispute, which has now been resolved with the intervention of the respectables.

In view of the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466***, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.200 dated 30.05.2017, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506 and 34 of the IPC (Sections 307 of the IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Basti Jodhewal, District Ludhiana and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
