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**ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)**

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.37 dated 28.02.2017, under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149, 506 of the IPC (Section 325 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga, on the basis of compromise, which has been arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is outcome of a sudden quarrel between the villagers, which has now been resolved with the intervention of the respectables.

A coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 20.07.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to record the statements of the parties with regard to genuineness of the compromise and send a report to

this Court. The report of JMIC, Moga dated 28.08.2017 has been received,

wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded which indicates that the compromise is genuine, without any coercion or undue influence.

The FIR is outcome of a sudden quarrel between the villagers, which has now been resolved with the intervention of the respectables.

In view of the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466*, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.37 dated 28.02.2017, under Sections 323, 324, 148, 148, 506 of the IPC (Section 325 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
